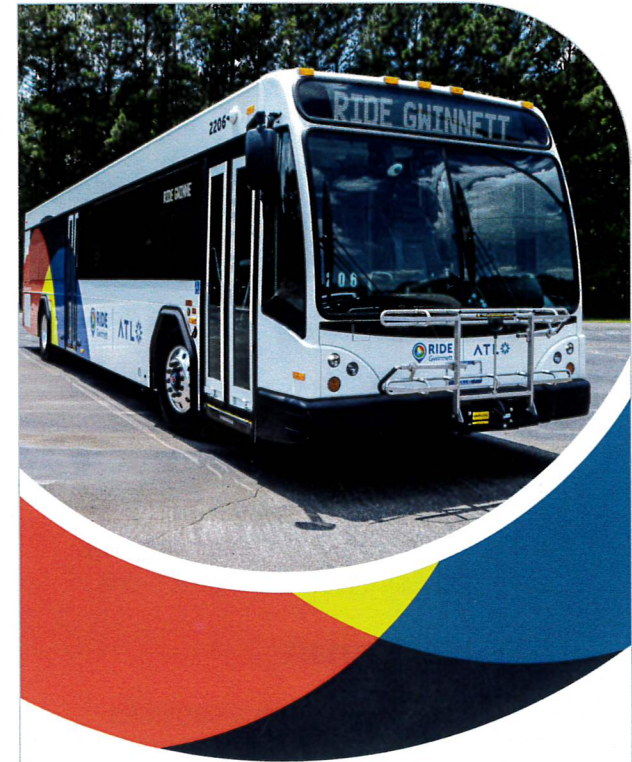

Local bus

Whether you're going to work, the doctor's office, or the park, Ride Gwinnett can take you there with local routes in Duluth, Norcross, and more.

ADA paratransit

Qualifying residents with disabilities can use Ride Gwinnett's shared-ride ADA paratransit service. This service accommodates riders who are unable to access or travel on the local fixed-route buses. Visit [RideGwinnett.com](https://www.ridegwinnett.com) to apply.

Microtransit

Enjoy the flexibility of microtransit, an on-demand shared-ride service that allows you to travel within the designated microtransit zone. Download the [Ride Gwinnett app](#) from your app store or call a dispatcher to book your ride.

Hours of operation

Hours vary by route and run Monday through Saturday each week. Visit our website for information on holiday hours, route schedules, and service updates.

Paying your fare

Local bus fare can be paid using a MARTA Breeze Card, Breeze Mobile, and cash. Vehicle operators will not be able to make change for riders. Microtransit riders can pay using the Ride Gwinnett app.

Accessible fleet

All Ride Gwinnett vehicles are ADA-approved. Our local buses, paratransit, and microtransit vehicles are equipped with ramps and lifts to accommodate wheelchairs and mobility devices.

Connecting to MARTA

Ride Gwinnett connects to MARTA at the following stations:

- Arts Center Station: Commuter Route 103A
- Civic Center Station: Commuter Routes 101, 102, and 103
- Doraville Station: Local Routes 10A, 10B, 20, and 35
- Indian Creek Station: Local Route 70

There are many reasons to use Ride Gwinnett for your transportation needs! When you use public transit, you contribute to a better community by:

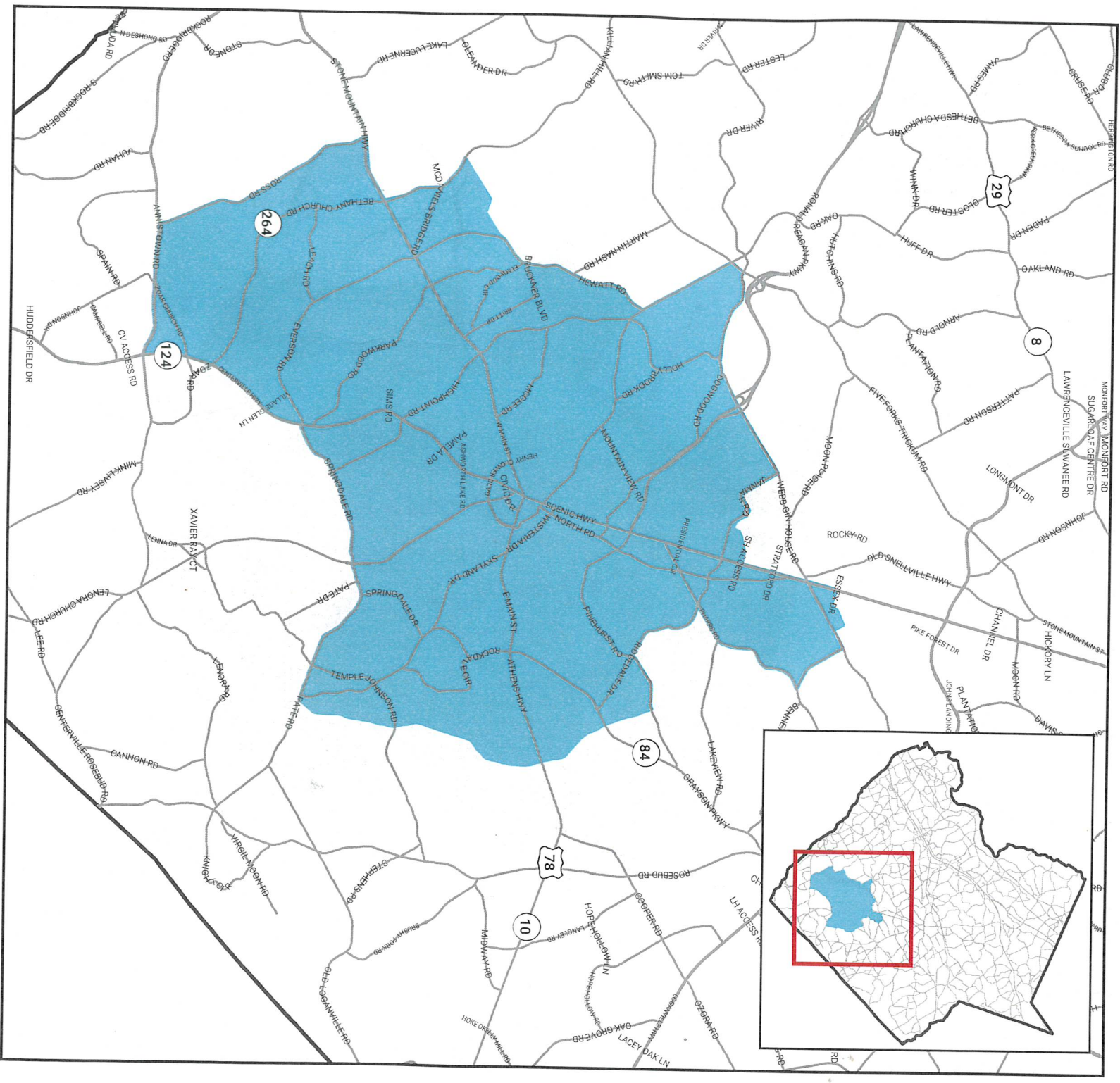
- Reducing emissions and helping to improve air quality
